



WhatWorks is a federal agency which recently reviewed all the research (about 900 articles) addressing and reported during March, 2007 the results for reading interventions. The figure represents how the treatment group compares to the normal values of the control group in terms of percentile difference from the mean. For example, if a subject improves X points on the test and his value resides on the control group continuum at 10% above the mean, then the figure would present the subject at the 10% value.

The QEEG activation method memory result would indicate that the subject was 48% above the norm of the control group. In this comparison, the highest value one can achieve is 50%. The reading scores addressed General Reading, Comprehension, Fluency, and Alphabetics. The average improvement value on these measures that were reported on the web were employed for the calculation.
